#### Trade Taskforce

The Forum's Trade Taskforce is focused on proactively identifying strategies to strengthen the bilateral trading relationship. As such, the Taskforce focuses on policy issues that impact industry invested in India and exporting to India. In addition to bilateral issues, the Taskforce looks at India's trade policy in the region and actions at WTO as it relates to U.S. industry issues.



#### SAWIE – South Asia Women in Energy

The South Asia Women in Energy (SAWIE) is a joint initiative by the US Agency for International Development (USAID) and the U.S.-India Strategic Partnership Forum (USISPF). SAWIE touches on two core aspects pertinent to India's growth, energy security and bridging the gender gap. SAWIE engages women professionals in the energy sector by focusing on outreach, mentorship and leadership, and professional development to help overcome these obstacles. SAWIE identifies and works with women leaders to promote gender-inclusive policies and motivates more women to seek careers in energy.



#### U.S.-India Alliance for Women's **Economic Empowerment - United** States Department of State

The U.S.-India Alliance for Women's Economic Empowerment seeks to facilitate women's economic participation in India by catalyzing commitments from the private sector, civil society and government leaders in both countries. A public-private partnership between the U.S. State Department, U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID), U.S.-India Strategic Partnership Forum and George Washington University, the Alliance works in cooperation with the private sector and civil society in both countries. Our members demonstrate that women's participation in the economy is not just good for the world, but also good for business.

### **USISPF** Initiatives



#### Hydrogen/Climate

USISPF has partnered with the US Trade and Development Agency to launch the US India Climate Technologies Action Group which facilitates the exchange of technology and capital to accelerate the clean energy sector. The Hydrogen Task Force is a collaboration with the Indian Ministry of New and Renewable Energy and the US Department of Energy to integrate the private sector into the deployment of hydrogen technologies.



#### US-India Tax Forum

USISPF has a dedicated and specialized platform in the US-India Tax Forum.

The Tax Forum leads engagements with tax policymakers at both the federal and state level and helps in furthering recommendations that propel the ease of doing business environment and mitigating tax barriers to entry. Launched in 2020, the Tax forum has since been a trusted platform bringing together public sector policymakers, global tax experts, and the business community at large to engage and advocate for a tax environment that is conducive.



#### Higher Education

The reform of trade and immigration barriers would benefit both the American and Indian economies. Indians are eager to study and work in the US, with huge contributions to the American economy and academia, which would be made easier by reforming visa laws. In turn, the implementation of NEP 2020 by the Indian government would allow for investment into higher education with the aim of developing India as a competitive destination for world-class education.



#### Corporate Social Responsibility

USISPF acts as the bridge between its member companies and government and nonprofit goals. USISPF's identification of opportunities and connections increases the value of our member companies' CSR investments.



### Healthcare

The pandemic has accentuated global fragilities and exposed healthcare systems around the globe. USISPF is committed to a dedicated focus on its healthcare vertical helping solve the pressing challenges pertaining to vaccine delivery and bringing together public sector health professionals to tackle epidemics and preclude the pernicious effects of air-borne diseases.

### Project "Strengthening Healthcare Amenities in Public-health Ecosystem" (SHAPE)

USISPF supported SEWA International's initiative "Strengthening Healthcare Amenities in Public-health Ecosystem (SHAPE)" covering 19 primary healthcare centers (PHCs) and 76 sub-centers across tiny villages in the state of Gujarat.

The objective of the project was to strengthen the primary healthcare ecosystem of two districts in Gujarat (including the Rann of Kutch region), by spreading awareness around preventive and curative healthcare, upgrading health centers through conducting a need assessment of current health infrastructure and focusing on capacity building of frontline health workers.

#### "Life Course Immunization: Pulse of a Resilient Health System"

Immunization programs are said to be cost-effective preventive measures to protect and promote public health. As the adage goes, prevention is better than cure, and so is immunization, which has had a significant impact on India's healthcare history. Immunization has played a significant part in prevention, and disease management, and helped to enhance the lifespan of individuals. USISPF has worked on an 18-month-long project to emphasize the need for India to explore the opportunities and gaps in immunization and has released a whitepaper titled "Life Course Immunization: Pulse of a Resilient Health System."



#### Start-up Connect

Startup Connect was designed for India-based startups that sought to grow and expand in the U.S. However, the Program has diversified, where founders can best expand their network and build relationships across the business and VC community at large. The Startup Connect Program provides a platform for founders and CEOs to mentor burgeoning tech talent and fledgling startups, leveraging B2B connectivity. The invaluable mentorship from Fortune 500 executives and robust support from a policy perspective seeks to help improve the regulatory environment for startups to expand in the U.S.

#### **BUSINESS POLICY ADVOCACY**

USISPF helps its member companies engage with federal and state governments on sector-specific policy advocacy, to provide ease of doing business and strengthen the economic and commercial partnership between the two countries.

#### CONNECTING THE DOTS

USISPF provides its stakeholders a platform to work together and to track opportunities at the state and federal level. USISPF also drives deeper collaboration by facilitating introductions between government and businesses, where appropriate.
