U.S.-India Tax Forum



The U.S.-India Tax Forum is USISPF's specialised tax policy platform.

The Tax Forum leads engagements with tax policymakers at both the federal and state level and helps in furthering recommendations that propel the ease of doing business environment and mitigating tax barriers to entry.

Launched in 2020, the Tax forum has since been a trusted platform bringing together public sector policymakers, global tax experts, and the business community at large to engage and advocate for a tax environment that is conducive.

Trade Task Force



The Forum's Trade Task force is focused on proactively identifying strategies to strengthen the bilateral trading relationship. The Task force focuses on policy issues that impact industry invested in India and exporting to India. In addition to bilateral issues, the Task force looks at India's trade policy in the region and actions at WTO as it relates to U.S. industry issues.

Climate and Sustainability



South Asia Women in Energy (SAWIE) – South Asia Women in Energy

The South Asia Women in Energy (SAWIE) is a joint initiative by the US Agency for International Development (USAID) and the U.S.-India Strategic Partnership Forum (USISPF). SAWIE touches on two core aspects pertinent to India's growth, energy security and bridging the gender gap. SAWIE engages women professionals in the energy sector by focusing on outreach, mentorship and leadership, and professional development to help overcome these obstacles. SAWIE identifies and works with women leaders to promote gender-inclusive policies and motivates more women to seek careers in energy.

Hydrogen Task Force

USISPF has partnered with the US Trade and Development Agency to launch the US India Climate Technologies Action Group which facilitates the exchange of technology and capital to accelerate the clean energy sector. The Hydrogen Task Force is a collaboration with the Indian Ministry of New and Renewable Energy and the US Department of Energy to integrate the private sector into the deployment of hydrogen technologies.

Climate Technologies Action Group

Launched in 2021, The US-India Climate Technologies Action Group (CTAG) is a joint project of the U.S. Trade and Development Agency (USTDA) and the US-India Strategic Partnership Forum (USISPF). The CTAG integrates private and public sector inputs on concrete initiatives that contribute to advanced global action on climate, facilitate U.S. industry input on the latest climate-resilient technologies, share US business models with the Indian market to accelerate the development of the clean energy sector, mobilize capital for climate-smart infrastructure projects in India and strengthen the US-India bilateral relationship.

USISPF Initiatives

U.S.-India Friendship Alliance

The US-India Friendship Alliance (USIFA) is a New York-based 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization founded in 2004 to foster cultural, educational, and socioeconomic ties between the United States and India. By working with experts from government, business, academia, and civil society, USIFA creates collaborations that bridge the gap between values and meaningful change.

The Alliance focuses on healthcare access, educational opportunity, women's empowerment, environmental awareness and cultural enhancement. Our outreach and advocacy allows us to fund high impact initiatives that uplift vulnerable Indian communities neglected by conventional charities.
